1. League Structure

2. Fixture

3. E-match card

Home team have to enter the umpires' number before submitting the match card. For any omission, the team will be penalised.

Captain of the match must be labelled on the match card.

Home team captain has the responsibility to ensure the umpires have submitted the match card before they leave. If it results in late submission, the home team may have the opportunity receiving penalty.

4. Walk-over

If any teams need to give a walk-over to the opponent, the team must inform the committee at least 24 hours before the game begins. If not, it will count as a no show.

5. U21 players

U21 players can play for their own designated team and the next higher-ranked team on the same day. If the players fulfil the above requirement, it will not count as one player movement.

There is no requirement on the sequence to be played.

6. Police and ambulance service

If any team have called police or ambulance, please inform the committee within 24 hours so we can follow up on the case. Please be reminded that if you want to call an ambulance at HKFC, please inform the staff first.

7. Player identity

All teams should prepare their team list with photo every match and need to show it upon request. If any team have doubts on the identity of a player, the captain has the rights to ask the umpire to check the HKID of the player. If any player cannot prove his identity upon request, he cannot participate in the match.

8. Umpire identity

If you have any doubts on the identity of the umpire, the team captains have the rights to request the umpire to provide his HKID. If the umpire fails to prove his identity, teams have the rights to ask him to stop umpiring game and continue the match in accordance to Competition Bye-law 13.2 when an umpire fails to turn up.

9. Playing kit

The home team should always wear their first strip colour unless both teams have made an agreement.

10. Mis-behaviour on pitch

If any team wants to complain about the mis-behaviour of the opponents, a video evidence need to be provided, otherwise it is difficult for the committee to start an investigation.

11. Red card

When a player receives a red card, he must leave the playing area immediately. For match played in HV1, HV2, LF, BS, the player must stay outside the fence. For match played in HKFC, the player can retreat to the spectator stand.

12. Disciplinary record

The disciplinary record will be circulated and updated on the website every 2 weeks. If you have enquiry on any player, please send email to office to confirm before playing a game.
