“Want more matches”

This depends on the pitch availability and number of teams enter each year

We learnt from our past. Our historical record shows that accidents that came to our attention were the one what were played with 6 or more male.

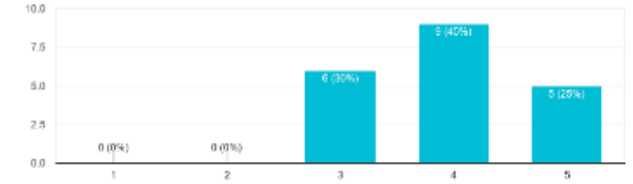
Teams are allowed to play with “6 male + 5 female” when both team captains and umpires have mutually agreed before the push back of the match.

- Prefer the default line-up to be 6 boys 5 girls

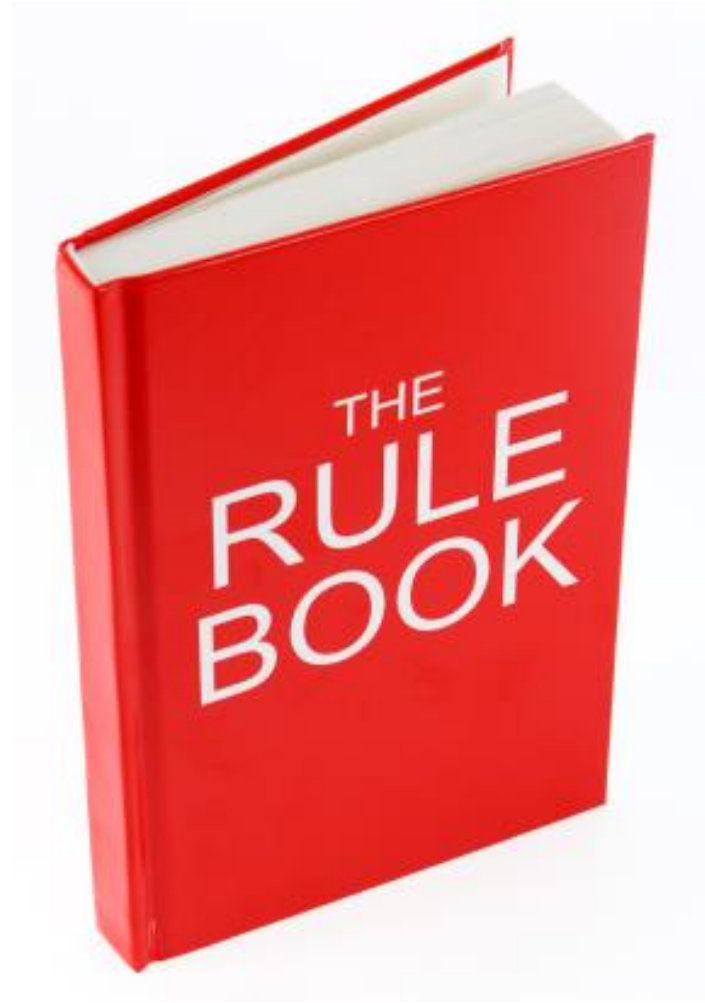

BYLAWS FOR HKHA SUMMER MIXED LEAGUE

(1) Composition of Teams

- All players participating for a team must be registered for that team prior to the start of the match.
- The maximum number of players that may participate in a match for any one team is

ALL PLAYERS, COACHES & UMPIRES MUST READ

- No team shall have more than **5 male field players** on the field of play at any one time. The restriction on the number of male field players shall always be met unless **BOTH** team captains have mutually agreed, prior to the start of the match, that **6 male field players** shall be permitted on each team and both umpires have been notified accordingly.

Note: The intention of the HKHA Summer Mixed League is to play with fully gender mixed teams and increasing the number of male field players to 6 should only be adopted if both teams are unable to field a suitable number of female players.

- There is no limit on the number of female players allowed on the field of play provided the total number of players on the field at any point in time does not exceed 11.

The Government announced the arrangements for inbound travellers from places outside Hong Kong to obtain a Provisional Vaccine Pass. Please note that only inbound travellers who have arrived in Hong Kong **on or after 1 May 2022** will be issued with a Provisional Vaccine Pass at the designated channels.  **Third stage of Vaccine Pass – Commenced on 31 May 2022**

• Q: What is Vaccine Pass?



A: The Vaccine Pass is an important anti-epidemic measure. It aims to encourage more people to get vaccinated while enabling residents to safely resume normal daily life. Starting from 24 February 2022 (10 February 2022 for Type D catering business premises), all persons aged 12 or above entering or remaining on the following specified premises

Composition of Teams

- TEAM = **16** players (11 field player + 5 substitutes)
- 11 field player =  x 5 (MAX) +  x 6 (Up to 11)
- No team shall have more than 5 male field players on the field of play at any one time. The restriction on the number of male field players shall always be met **unless BOTH team captains have mutually agreed, prior to the start of the match, that 6 male field players shall be permitted on each team and both umpires have been notified accordingly.**

Note: The intention of the HKHA Summer Mixed League is to play with fully gender mixed teams and increasing the number of male field players to 6 should only be adopted if both teams are unable to field a suitable number of female players.

Composition of Teams (cont.)

A “Field Player with Goalkeeping Privileges” is no longer available.

Teams have now **2** options:

- 1)** **Play with a Goalkeeper** who wears protective equipment comprising at least headgear, leg guards and kickers and who is also permitted to wear goalkeeping hand protectors and other protective equipment.

OR

- 2)** **Play with Field Players only.**



Special Rules

- 1) Goal scored by  2 goals

- 2) “Hitting” is not permitted anywhere on the field, this includes **Forehand Hit** and **Reverse Hit** (aka. Tomahawk). However, a **Sweep** (aka. Slap) is permitted anywhere on the pitch outside the two circles.

- 3) No **Penalty Corners** (Short-corner)

- 4) No **Penalty strokes** (P-Flick)

- 5) Stick above the shoulder is not permitted



- 6) A goal is awarded when field players position themselves with the intention of stopping the ball from going in with any part of their body.



Special Rules

Not permitted anywhere on the field



Reverse Hit (Tomahawk)

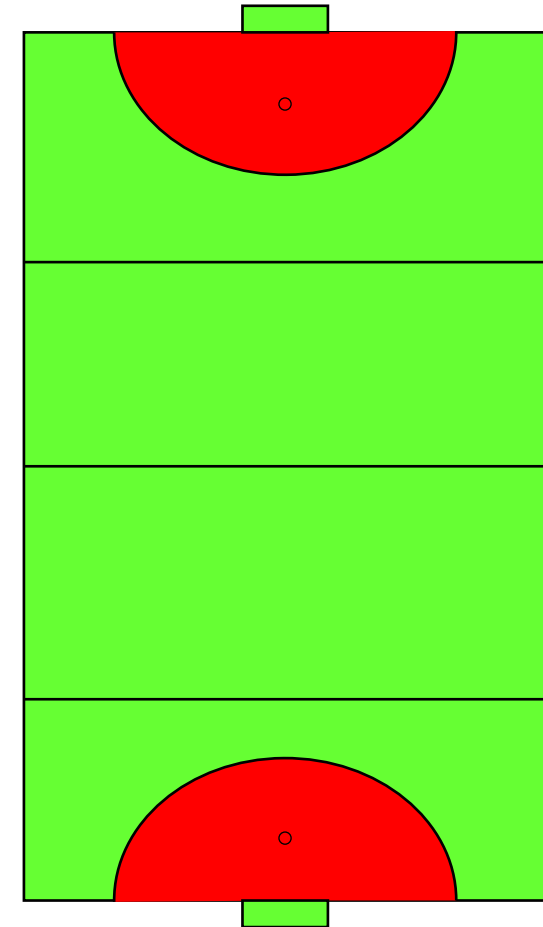

Permitted outside the "D" area – only when under control

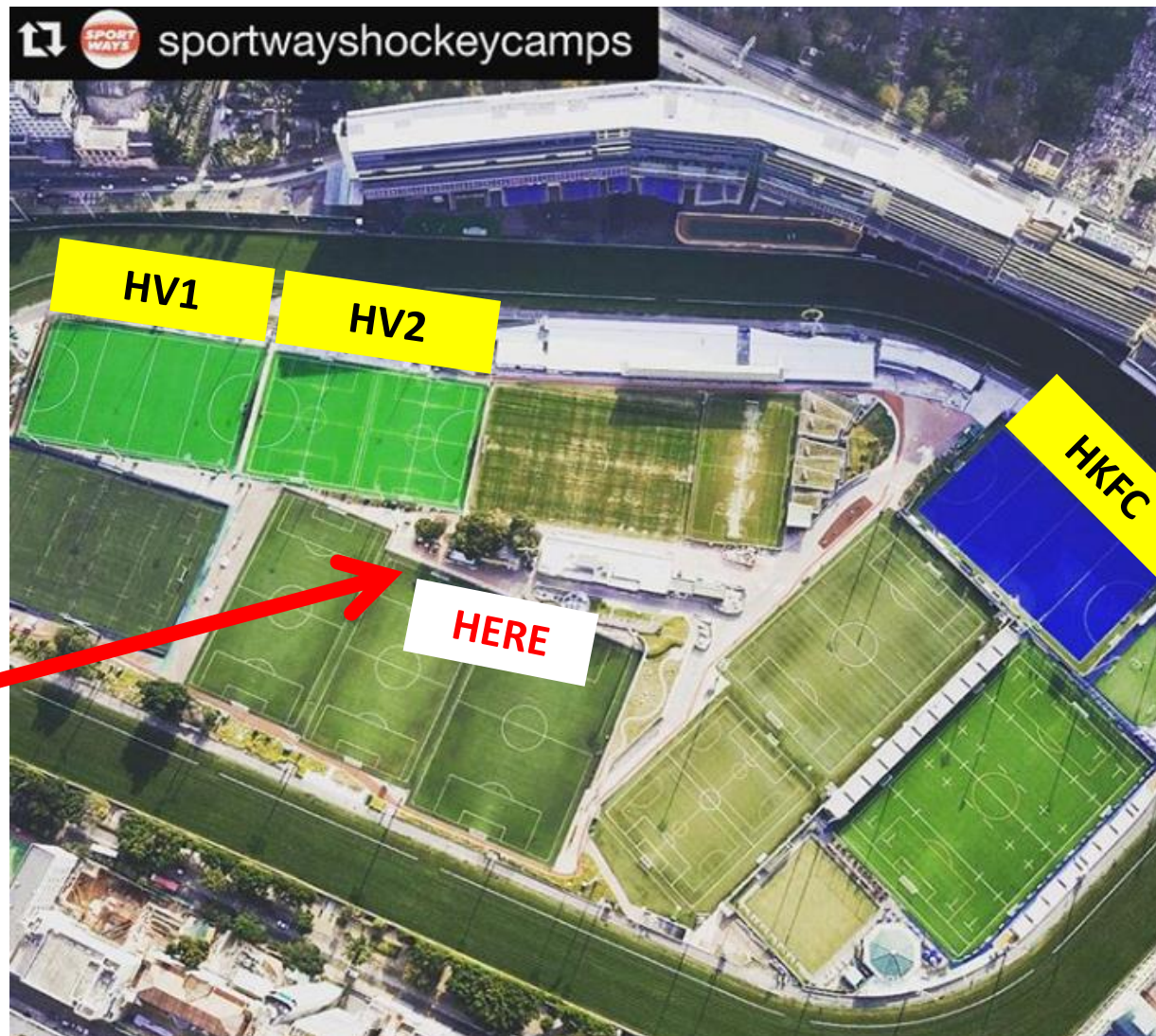

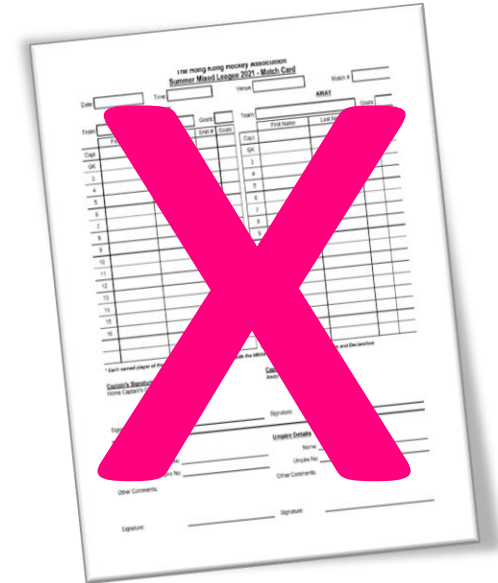

- Avoid “uniform colour clash”



Umpires

- Must be a **HKHA registered umpire**

Failure to provide an umpire as required will be treated very seriously and may result in a team or a club being banned from this and/or future summer leagues.

- Umpires **MUST** report the award of Yellow and Red cards to the HKHA, by text message, e-mail or fax within **forty-eight (48) hours** of the end of the match.
