- 5) Simon Shepherdson reported on the Mens League which was overtaken with the event in November with the 4 teams involved, and after the event the focus turning to 2 teams to attend the World Cup events in Cape Town (O40 and Auckland (O50) started
- 6) Financial Report for the year ending March, 2024 was tabled. Main expense of the event in November has led to a deficit for the year, which will still look to be mitigated if additional subvention funds can be allocated.
